CHANNELIZING THE POWER OF YOUTH: 1M1B CHANGE THE WORLD INTERNSHIPS 2015 & PRESENTATION AT THE UNITED NATIONS HEADQUARTERS, NEW YORK



1M1B's flagship program 'Change The World' was launched in April/ May 2015 in New York and seven Caribbean Islands in partnership with the Global Leadership Coalition (GLC) and in New Delhi, India with Connecting Dreams Foundation (CDF). Out of the 500+ applications, 25 participants were selected and mentored extensively for 6 months by various international mentors on a global entrepreneurship curriculum. The teams were mentored on their social ventures individually by 1M1B mentors. The teams worked in their communities to develop sustainable ventures which ranged from Agri-products, jewelry, food products, utility products to even developing creative products for voicing opinions and mobile apps for farmers.

The top five teams presented their work at the United Nations Headquarters on the occasion of United Nations International day for the eradication of poverty (IDEP) on 16th October 2015. The event 'Activating Youth Entrepreneurship & Employment' was moderated by Manav Subodh, Co-founder, 1M1B and was jointly organized by 1M1B and 'World We Want' in partnership with GLC, EndPoverty2015 and UN-Habitat.

The top five teams also got an opportunity to present their work to Washington DC ArchAngels, a prominent venture capital group in the United States.

PEER MENTORING ACROSS SOCIO-ECONOMIC DIVIDE: 1M1B MENTORSHIP PROGRAM (PART OF MCKINSEY SOCIAL INITIATIVES PROJECT 'GENERATION')

The four months peer mentorship program began in late August 2015 for the General Duty Assistants, the entry level position at hospitals with the responsibility of patient care. The objective of McKinsey's Generation project is to support entry level personnel through the initial few weeks in a new job, in this case at the hospital, helping them overcome the initial road blocks. The broad objective is to close the skills gap and improve the employment prospects. 1M1B joined hands with MSI in this pilot project that was undertaken by them for the first time in India.

1M1B, with its executive partner Connecting Dreams Foundation, recruited and trained 20 students and young professionals from New Delhi, India to mentor approx. 90 new GDAs. Structured weekly reporting formats and meetings kept the mentors on track. This pilot project brought useful insights prior to commencing the full scale project in mid 2016.

The 5 finalists of the 1M1B Change The World Internships 2015 from India also presented their projects on this occasion.

REACHING OUT TO THE FUTURE ENTREPRENEURS IN THE COMMUNITY: ENTREPRENEURSHIP WORKSHOP (LEVEL-1) PRESENTED JOINTLY BY 1M1B AND NAVBHARAT TIMES

1M1B partnered with NavBharat Times, a leading Hindi Daily newspaper, to conduct a workshop on basic level of entrepreneurship on 19th December 2015 at New Delhi. The event had over 80 participants in attendance from varied backgrounds. With this workshop, 1M1B has expanded its reach to the local community level entrepreneurs as well. The workshop was conducted by Manav Subodh, Co-founder, 1M1B.



EXPANDING 1M1B'S DIGITAL CONNECT

'1M1B E-WEEKENDS', a virtual classroom based program on entrepreneurship, was launched in December 2015. The objective of this program is to reach out to aspiring entrepreneurs, and expose them to a global entrepreneurship curriculum while at the same time mentor them on a two months project that each will undertake individually.

MOVING AHEAD IN 2016

Expanding the network of 1M1B Microaccelerators within India, other SAARC countries, and Vietnam.

1M1B MICROACCELERATOR IN GUPTKASHI, UTTARAKHAND

In November 2015 1M1B launched its 6 months long 1M1B Fellowship Program with the prime focus of having fellows from the cities, along with the 1M1B Team, work in the local community in the state of Uttarakhand, a beautiful hill state in the Himalayan belt of north India. 1M1B will set up its Microaccelerators here for initiating social entrepreneurship initiatives. The pilot program is supported by the Uttarakhand Mandal of America (UMA). The first 1M1B Microaccelerator is being set up at JVNS, a school at Guptkashi in Rudraprayag district of Uttarakhand. The centre aims to impact about 1200 lives, and 300 families in this village. The telemedicine activities of the centre have started on pilot scale from this centre from February 2016. In the next few weeks other social ventures like tourism and product manufacturing from recycled material will be initiated. Through its microaccelerators 1M1B will be offering employment to local community members in addition to offering scholarship to participating students from the region.
